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## 1. INTRODUCTION

- ❖ This prospectus relates to admission to various Diploma programs, Degree (UG), and Postgraduate (PG) under the Allied Health Sciences stream conducted at MIMS College of Allied Health Sciences, Malappuram. The programs offered, approved intake capacity, and contact details of institution are provided in Annexure-I.
- ❖ The College has decided to conduct a separate selection procedure for the admission of candidates to various Allied Health Sciences Programs at the Diploma, UG, and PG levels.
- ❖ This prospectus contains the rules, regulations, and guidelines applicable for the selection and admission to various Allied Health Sciences Programs for the academic year 2026–27 at MIMS College of Allied Health Sciences, limited to Management Quota seats, as approved by the Admission Supervisory and Fee Regulatory Committee (AFRC), Government of Kerala.
- ❖ This prospectus is common to all Programs Conducted in the College for the academic year 2026–27
- ❖ There shall be no separate institutional policy or reservation followed by the college unless otherwise specifically stated in this prospectus.

## 3. CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY OF ADMISSION

### 3.1. NATIONALITY

- ❖ Candidates seeking admission must be Citizens of India or dependents of Non-Resident Indians (NRI), as per the norms prescribed by the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee (AFRC), Government of Kerala, and other applicable regulations by DME, Govt. of Kerala, & KUHS, Thrissur

#### **4. ACADEMIC**

#### **5. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

##### **5.1 DIPLOMA PROGRAM/S**

- ❖ The candidate shall have passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) conducted by the Government of Kerala or any other examination recognized as equivalent by the Directorate of Medical Education (DME), Government of Kerala, with a minimum of 40% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (PCB) taken together, or as per the norms prescribed by the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Profession (NCAHP), Government of India

##### **5.2 UG PROGRAM/S**

- ❖ Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) conducted by the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, **or** any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto, with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (PCB) taken together, shall be eligible for admission, as per the norms prescribed by the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) or the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Profession (NCAHP), Government of India

##### **5.3 PG PROGRAM/S**

###### **5.3.1. MASTER OF HOSPITAL ADMINISTRATION (MHA)**

- ❖ As per the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) admission criteria, candidates must have passed any full-time, regular Degree programme from a UGC-recognized University with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks.

###### **5.3.2. MSC.MLT (BIOCHEMISTRY), MSC.MLT (PATHOLOGY) AND MSC.MLT (MICROBIOLOGY)**

- ❖ Candidates who have passed the B.Sc. Medical Laboratory Technology (B.Sc. MLT) degree from the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) or from any other University recognized as equivalent by KUHS, with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks in all years of the B.Sc. MLT examination, or as per the norms prescribed by the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Profession (NCAHP), Government of India, shall be eligible.

#### **6. MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION**

- ❖ The medium of instruction and examination for all programmes shall be English.

## **7. AFFILIATION OF THE COLLEGE**

- ❖ All Postgraduate (PG) and Degree (UG) programmes offered by MIMS College of Allied Health Sciences are affiliated to the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), Thrissur. The Diploma programmes are approved by the Directorate of Medical Education (DME), Government of Kerala.

## **8. DURATION OF THE PROGRAM**

- ❖ The duration of all Diploma program/s shall be two (2) years, as per the norms prescribed by the Directorate of Medical Education (DME), Government of Kerala or as per the norms prescribed by the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Profession (NCAHP), Government of India
- ❖ The Diploma in Operation Theatre and Anaesthesia Technology (DOTAT), Diploma in Endoscopy Technology and Diploma in Neuro Technology programme shall be of two (2) years duration with an additional six (6) months of compulsory internship, making a total duration of two and a half (2.5) years, for candidates who have passed the course as per DME norms or as per the norms prescribed by the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Profession (NCAHP), Government of India
- ❖ The Degree (UG) program/s shall be of four (4) years duration, incorporating theory, practical, and clinical posting hours in each academic year, as per the syllabus and regulations of the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) or as per the norms prescribed by the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Profession (NCAHP), Government of India.
- ❖ The Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT) programme shall be of four (4) years duration with an additional six (6) months of compulsory internship or as per the norms prescribed by the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Profession (NCAHP), Government of India.
- ❖ The Postgraduate (PG) program/s shall be of two (2) years duration, comprising theory and practical/clinical training, as prescribed by the KUHS syllabus or as per the norms prescribed by the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Profession (NCAHP), Government of India.

## **9. RELAXATION IN MARKS**

- ❖ For all program/s, relaxation in minimum qualifying marks, wherever applicable, shall be provided as per the Government Orders (GOs) issued by the Government of Kerala or as per the norms prescribed by the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Profession (NCAHP), Government of India for Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC), Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), and Other Eligible Communities (OEC).
- ❖ Relaxation of marks is applicable for merit quota for all programs as prescribed by Government of Kerala
- ❖ Candidates claiming relaxation in marks shall produce valid certificates issued by the competent authority at the time of admission.
- ❖ There shall be no reservation of seats for SEBC / SC / ST / OEC candidates under the Management Quota

## 10. AGE LIMIT

- ❖ Applicants shall have completed 17 years of age for Degree and Diploma program/s as on 31st December 2026.
- ❖ No relaxation in the age limit shall be permitted under any circumstances

## 11. HOW TO APPLY

### 11.1 APPLICATION FEE

- **Diploma Programmes:** ₹ 750/- per application
- **UG and PG Programmes:** ₹ 1,000/- per application

### 11.2 APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- ❖ Applications shall be submitted online only through the official website of Aster MIMS Academy: <https://astermimsacademy.com>
- ❖ An independent application shall be submitted for each UG programme, using the prescribed links, by paying the stipulated application fee separately for each programme.
- ❖ Candidates shall create a Login ID and password by registering on the website.
- ❖ Candidates shall fill in the required personal details correctly and completely.
- ❖ Candidates shall upload the following documents:
  - ❖ Recent passport-size colour photograph taken against a white/light-coloured background
    - Format: JPEG / PNG
    - Maximum size: 50 KB
    - Dimensions: 120 × 150 pixels (4.23 × 5.29 cm)
- ❖ Qualifying examination mark lists and Degree certificate, wherever applicable
- ❖ Scanned signature of the candidate
- ❖ The prescribed application fee shall be paid online through the payment gateway provided on the website.
- ❖ A formal receipt will be generated and sent to the registered email ID after successful payment.
- ❖ After submission, candidates shall generate and retain a PDF copy of the completed application form for future reference. (No hard copy of the application needs to be sent to the office.)
- ❖ No opportunity shall be provided to modify or submit additional details/documents after the closing date of application.
- ❖ Application ones applied cannot be changed.
- ❖ Incomplete or late applications shall be rejected, and the application fee once remitted shall not be refunded under any circumstances

## **12. NRI Seats**

- ❖ 15% of the total approved seats in each programme shall be earmarked for Non-Resident Indian (NRI) candidates, as per the norms prescribed by the Government of Kerala / AFRC / NCAHP

## **13. PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING FOR NRI SEATS**

- ❖ Applicants seeking admission under the NRI quota shall apply online through the Aster MIMS Academy portal and shall opt for colleges offering NRI seats during the application process.

### **13.1. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR NRI CANDIDATES**

- ❖ Candidates applying under the NRI quota shall produce the following documents at the time of admission:
  - Sponsorship Certificate executed on stamp paper along with a Declaration from the Sponsor.
  - Employment Certificate of the Sponsor, issued by the employer.
  - Valid Passport copy of the Sponsor along with Embassy Certificate / Consulate Certificate / Green Card / OCI documents, as applicable.
  - In case of non-submission of Embassy Certificate, employment endorsement in the passport or a valid employment contract shall be accepted.
  - Visa copy of the Sponsor, duly attested by the Indian Embassy / Consulate.
  - Attested copy of the relevant passport page showing the Employment Visa stamp.
  - If this is not available, an Employment Certificate duly attested by the Indian Embassy or Consulate shall be produced.
  - Relationship Certificate issued by the Village Officer / Tahsildar (Mandatory).
  - The relationship between the candidate and the sponsor shall strictly comply with the Government Orders issued vide  
GO (Rt) No.1616/2024/H&FWD dated 04.07.2024 and  
GO (Rt) No.1556/2024/H&FWD dated 28.06.2024.

## **14. PREPARATION OF MERIT LIST**

### **14.1. MERIT LIST**

- ❖ Out of the 50% Management Quota seats, 35% of the total seats shall be filled as Management Merit Seats, and 15% of the total seats shall be filled as NRI Seats, from among the online applications received, strictly based on eligibility criteria and merit.
- ❖ The allotment of NRI Seats shall be governed by GO (Rt) No.375/2020/H&FWD dated 22.02.2020 issued by the Government of Kerala, as amended from time to time.
- ❖ If NRI seats are not available, the entire 50% Management Quota seats shall be filled as Management Merit Seats by the college from among the eligible applications received, based on the merit list

prepared using marks obtained in the qualifying examination in the core subjects, as specified in the eligibility criteria.

- ❖ Unfilled NRI seats, if any, shall be converted to Management Merit Seats and filled strictly on the basis of merit.

#### **14.2 PROCEDURE FOR NORMALIZATION OF MARKS**

- ❖ The marks obtained by candidates in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and the qualifying examination, conducted by various Boards, shall be normalized to make them comparable with the marks obtained by candidates who have passed the qualifying examination conducted by the Directorate of Higher Secondary Examination (DHSE), Kerala.

#### **14.3 RESOLUTION OF TIE WHILE RANKING**

- ❖ In the event of a tie in the total marks computed for ranking, the tie shall be resolved in the following order:
  1. Candidate with higher marks in English (Plus Two) shall be ranked higher.
  2. If the tie persists, candidate with higher marks in Biology (Plus Two) shall be ranked higher.
  3. If the tie persists, candidate with higher marks in Chemistry (Plus Two) shall be ranked higher.
  4. If the tie persists, candidate with higher marks in Physics (Plus Two) shall be ranked higher.
  5. If the tie persists, the aggregate percentage of marks obtained in Plus One and Plus Two together in the core subjects shall be considered.
  6. If the tie still persists, the older candidate shall be ranked higher.
  7. If the tie remains unresolved even thereafter, the tie shall be resolved based on criteria decided by the Dean / Principal / Head of the Institution, whose decision shall be final and binding

#### **15. PUBLICATION OF RANK LIST**

- ❖ Separate Rank Lists for each program/s shall be published on the official website of Aster MIMS Academy - <https://astermimsacademy.com> on the dates specified in the Admission Schedule provided on the last page of this Prospectus.

#### **15.1 VALIDITY OF RANK LIST**

- ❖ The Rank Lists for Allied Health Sciences program/s shall remain valid up to the cut-off date prescribed by the Government of Kerala and/or the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) / NCAHP, Govt. of India, as applicable.

#### **16. ALLOTMENT/S**

- ❖ There shall be three (3) rounds of online allotment, as specified in the Admission Schedule published along with this Prospectus.

- ❖ Candidates who are allotted a seat shall report to the college for selection interview and document verification and join the programme within three (3) days from the date of allotment/selection intimation, after remitting the full programme fee.
- ❖ Failure to join within the prescribed time shall result in the automatic cancellation of the allotment, and the seat shall be treated as vacant.
- ❖ Candidates who are selected after the interview/document verification but fail to remit the prescribed college fee within the stipulated date shall have their admission summarily cancelled, and the seat shall be allotted to the next eligible candidate in the rank list.
- ❖ No further claim for admission shall be entertained under any circumstances.

## **17. SPOT ALLOTMENT**

- ❖ Spot allotment shall be conducted only against vacancies available under the Management Quota.
- ❖ Government-lapsed seats, if any, shall be filled only after obtaining prior permission and approval from the Academic Supervisory Committee and the Government of Kerala, in cases where no candidates are available for allotment from the Government side.
- ❖ The date, time, and venue of the Spot Allotment shall be published only after obtaining prior approval from the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee (AFRC) and shall be duly notified through the official website and/or leading newspapers, as applicable.
- ❖ Spot allotment shall be conducted based on the vacant Management Quota seats, including lapsed seats, available in the institution.
- ❖ Details regarding: Number of vacant seats, Eligibility criteria to participate, Procedure/method of allotment, and Reporting and admission formalities, shall be notified separately through the official communication channels after receiving AFRC approval.

## **18. SELECTION AND VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS**

- ❖ Candidates who are provisionally selected shall be intimated by the institution to appear for a selection interview and verification of original documents.
- ❖ The Principal / Head of the Institution shall be personally responsible for verifying the original certificates/documents and for satisfying themselves regarding the authenticity and correctness of the records produced by the candidate.
- ❖ If, at any stage of the admission process, any discrepancy, mismatch in marks, or false information is detected in the details furnished by the candidate for the purpose of securing admission, the candidature/admission shall be summarily rejected or cancelled, without any further notice.

### **18.1 ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES TO BE SUBMITTED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION**

- ❖ Candidates shall produce the following original certificates/documents at the time of admission, along with self-attested photocopies wherever required:
  - SSLC (10th) and Plus Two (12th) Pass Certificates – for proof of date of birth (Original)
  - Degree Mark Lists (for PG programmes) – (Original)
  - Degree Certificate / Provisional Degree Certificate (for PG programmes) – (Original)

- Transfer Certificate (TC) – (Original)
- Eligibility Certificate and Migration Certificate, wherever applicable
- Certificate of Good Conduct from the institution last attended, issued within the last six (6) months – (Original)
- Nativity Certificate, wherever applicable
- Income Certificate – wherever applicable
- In cases where candidates claim any reservation or preference as applicable to a particular college, supporting documents as specified in Annexure–I shall be produced.
- Community Certificate in proof of SEBC / OEC / SC / ST status, issued by the Village Officer and certified by the Tahsildar, wherever applicable
- Caste certificate--, issued within the last six (6) months – (Original)
- Aadhaar Card – (Copy)
- Medical/Fitness Certificate, including disability certificate where applicable
- Recent passport-size photographs, taken against a white/light-coloured background
- Additional documents required for NRI candidates, as specified under the NRI Quota guidelines

## **19. SPECIAL INSTRUCTION/S**

### **19.1. COURSE DISCONTINUATION / LIQUIDATED DAMAGES**

- ❖ If any candidate discontinues the course after the cut-off date of admissions as notified by the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) or the Competent Authority, the candidate shall be bound to comply with the liquidated damages clause as specified in the Government Prospectus.
- ❖ Only after fulfilling the above conditions shall the candidate be eligible to collect the original certificates and Transfer Certificate (TC) from the institution

## **20. ANTI-RAGGING REGULATION/S**

### **20.1. DEFINITION OF RAGGING**

- ❖ As per the Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1998, “ragging” means any act committed by disorderly conduct towards a student of an educational institution, which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm, or fear, apprehension, shame, or embarrassment to such student.
- ❖ It includes teasing, abusing, playing practical jokes, causing physical hurt, or forcing a student to do any act which he or she would not ordinarily be willing to do.

### **20.2. PUNISHMENT FOR RAGGING / MISCONDUCT**

- ❖ Ragging or any form of misconduct towards any student within or outside the college campus shall be treated as a criminal offence and will be immediately reported to the police.
- ❖ Students found guilty of ragging will not be permitted to continue their studies in the institution.

### 20.3. MANDATORY ANTI-RAGGING AFFIDAVIT

- ❖ At the time of admission, both the student and parent/guardian must submit an Anti-Ragging Affidavit as prescribed by the University Grants Commission (UGC) through the official website:

### 21. CODE OF CONDUCT

- ❖ Every student shall strictly adhere to the code of conduct prescribed by the institution to which he/she is admitted.
- ❖ It is mandatory for students to wear the prescribed uniform, identity card (ID card), black executive shoes, and to maintain properly tied hair as per the institutional guidelines.
- ❖ Any matter not specifically covered in this prospectus shall be decided by the undersigned, and his decision shall be final and binding.

M.Sc. Medical Laboratory Technology (M.Sc. MLT) admission schedules shall be finalized based on the declaration of UG results of the BSc MLT by the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS).

### 22.4. IMPORTANT NOTICE

- ❖ The fee structure mentioned above for the academic year 2026–27 is proposed by the college and is subject to revision in accordance with the fee fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee (FRC), as per the rules and regulations prescribed by the Committee. The fee may also be revised annually based on such regulations.
- ❖ In addition to the prescribed tuition fee, students shall remit the proportionate examination fee as notified by the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) from time to time. Hostel, mess, and transportation (bus) charges, if applicable, shall be levied separately.
- ❖ If the fee approved by the Fee Regulatory Committee (FRC) is lower than the fee proposed by the college, the excess amount already collected shall be refunded to the students by the institution.
- ❖ If the fee fixed by the FRC is higher than the proposed fee, students shall be liable to remit the additional amount as notified by the college.
- ❖ All fees shall be collected strictly in accordance with the orders of the FRC applicable for the academic year 2026–27.
